Pattern Dances for the 2012/2013 Season

All skaters, coaches and officials are advised that the Pattern Dances to be skated for the 2012/2013 season are as follows:

Ice Dance

Elementary – Group 1 – Dutch Waltz, Canasta Tango

Pre-Primary – Group 1 – Canasta Tango, Fourteenstep

Primary – as per ISU Communication 1670 – Basic Novice – Foxtrot and American Waltz

Novice – as per ISU Communication 1670 – Advanced Novice

Local, State and National Competitions - Rocker Foxtrot, Blues

National Championships - Starlight Waltz, Kilian

Music requirements for Pattern Dances for Ice Dance – as per ISU Communication 1721

The current series of ISU Dance Music shall be used for the Pattern Dances, with the following exceptions where couples are to provide their own music.

Primary – Foxtrot

Novice - Rocker Foxtrot and Kilian

The music chosen must be in accordance with the Rhythm of the Pattern Dance. The tempo throughout the required Sequences must be constant and in accordance with the required tempo of the Pattern Dance plus or minus 2 beats per minute.

The chosen music may be a tune from the ISU Ice Dance music. In this case, only tunes 1 to 5 can be chosen and the Couple shall furnish the competition music.

The music provided by the Couple, the start of the first Step of the dance must be on beat 1 of a measure (unless otherwise specified in the description of the dance).

Solo Dance - Group 3

Elementary - Canasta Tango

Pre-Primary – Fourteenstep

Primary - Rocker Foxtrot

Open - Westminster Waltz

Adult – Ten Fox
