<b>Entry Closing Date</b>	Saturday 22 <sup>nd</sup> June 2019
<b>Date of Official Draw</b>	Saturday 13 <sup>th</sup> July at 9.30am at the IceArenA. For 2 program events the order of skating in the Free Skate segment will be the reverse order of the Short Program result

<b>Ice Dimensions</b>	56m x 26m
<b>Divisions</b>	Technical Programs only. Aussie Skate to Senior Singles and Synchro, and to Basic Novice Pairs. Adult, all divisions. Ice Dance by expression of interest prior to the closing date only
<b>Technical Requirements</b>	As per current ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules, ISU Communications, ISA Regulations and Communications.
<b>Marking System</b>	The IJS (ISU Judging System) will be used for all ISA Divisions. Aussie Skate will be marked using the current 6.0 system unless otherwise advised prior to the event
<b>Results</b>	Results displayed or announced will remain provisional until certified by the Referee and Technical Controller on the official result form
<b>Judges</b>	Judging panel will be organised by the SA judging convener
<b>Membership Requirements</b>	At close of entries, all competitors must be financial members of SAISA (or another State body) and the membership must be valid during the full competition period. All <b>Aussie Skate</b> entrants must also be registered with ISA
<b>Practice Sessions</b>	Official Practices are not available for Aussie Skate levels and may need to be restricted for other levels. Skaters will be informed after close of entries

## COMPETITION ENTRY DETAILS

<b>Entry Process</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Entry registration forms, PPC forms and music forms are SAISA on-line forms. The links are on the SAISA website &gt; Forms page</li> <li>• You upload your music with the music form (further information below). Note that you must also have your music on a back-up CD</li> </ul>
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<b>Entry Conditions</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Entry form, music and fee must be received by close of entries (22 June), and PPC form by 6 July, for the entry to be complete</li> <li>• Interstate competitors must notify their association prior to entering</li> <li>• Relevant State Associations will be asked to verify entries from interstate skaters</li> </ul>	
<b>Payment Process</b>	Direct deposit to SAISA Account BSB 105-105 Account 389743040 (Bank SA). Synchro Team entry fees must be received in total as a team payment	
<b>Withdrawals</b>	Refund only with a medical certificate provided <b>before the draw</b> . <b>No refund permitted after the draw.</b>	
<b>Music</b>	<p>There are 3 aspects to submitting your music:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>1. The name</b> The name of your music is needed for your Entry form</li> <li><b>2. Backup CD</b> Skaters must have a backup CD with their music that they have tested on the rink's CD system; they must bring this CD to Official Practice and the Competition</li> <li><b>3. Online submission of your music</b> By close of entries skaters must submit their music electronically <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>The Upload link:</b> See SAISA website &gt; Forms page for the link</li> <li>• <b>The format: MP3</b></li> <li>• <b>Free Skate and Short Program:</b> these must be on separate CDs and separate uploads. Only Advanced Novice, Junior and Senior have Short Programs</li> <li>• <b>Naming: File naming examples</b> are below for ISA levels and Aussie Skate and consist of: the accepted name of the division (and segment if applicable), your name, and the actual length of your music: e.g.: JuniorLadies_SP_JaneSmith_2m40s AS_FS2_DonnaSmith_1m30s</li> </ul> </li> </ol>	
<b>Schedule</b>	A detailed schedule of events will be provided following the closing of entries and published on the SAISA website. Please note that the final schedule will be dependant on entry numbers and judge availability. The ice availability and possible placement of some divisions is below.

<b>Awards/Trophies</b>	Medals will be awarded to all competitors	
<b>Coach Accreditation</b>	Level 1 coaches and higher only are eligible to present skaters. Coaches must be current members of SAISA or another State body and wear their APSA accreditation ID with evidence of currency with APSA	

<b>Volunteering</b>	Volunteers are essential for the competition. It can't run without volunteers. Assistance will be needed for: Registration, Ice Marshalling, Runner, Printing results, Laying out and/or packing up the IJS, Hospitality for volunteers, Medal & Certificate presentation, Official Practice, Music and Announcing. The entry form contains a section where you can nominate your preferred volunteering offer which will be greatly appreciated
