Technical Requirements	As per current ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules, ISU Communications, ISA Regulations and Communications.
Other Requirements	State Championship entrants must have met championship eligibility requirements. See Policy section on the SAISA website.
Results	The IJS (ISU Judging System) will be used for all ISA Divisions. Unless notified otherwise before the event, Aussie Skate will be marked using the Aussie Skate 6.0 system, which is closed marking. Results displayed or announced will remain provisional until certified by the Referee (Aussie Skate) or the Referee and Technical Controller (ISA) on the official result form
Judges	Judging panel will be organised by the SA judging convenor in collaboration with the ISA Chair Judging and Officials as required
Membership Requirements	At close of entries, all competitors must be full financial members of SAISA (or another State body) and the membership must be valid during the full competition period. All Aussie Skate entrants must also be registered with ISA

Eligibility to Compete	Skaters Preliminary and above must have passed the relevant test level/s at the close of entries. Championship entrants also must have met the Championship requirements (Policy Section SAISA website) Competitors in Aussie Skate divisions must compete at the highest test level passed by the competition closing date and cannot enter a level lower than that which they have previously competed. Skaters who have passed the ISA Preliminary Test are not permitted to compete at Aussie Skate level (see ISA Rules for Pair and Dance exceptions). Interstate competitors may enter the Championship events but are not eligible for Championship titles
Practice Sessions	Official Practices are not available for Aussie Skate levels and may need to be restricted for other levels. Skaters will be informed after close of entries

The links are on the SAISA website > Forms page • You upload your music with the music form (further information below). Note that you must also have your music on a back-up CD
Payment Process	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Direct deposit to SAISA Account BSB 105-105 Account 389743040 (Bank SA) • Synchro Team entry fees must be received in total as a team payment
Entry Conditions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Entry form and fee must be received by close of entries (21 September), and PPC and music by 5 October, for the entry to be complete (incomplete entries cannot proceed to the Draw) • Interstate competitors must notify their association prior to entering • Relevant State Associations will be asked to verify entries from interstate skaters • Late entries will not be accepted
Withdrawals	Refund only with a medical certificate provided before the draw . No refund permitted after the draw
Music	<p>There are 3 aspects to submitting your music:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The name The name of your music is needed for your Entry form 2. Backup CD Skaters must have a backup CD with their music that they have tested on the rink's CD system; they must bring this CD to Official Practice and the Competition 3. Online submission of your music By close of entries skaters must submit their music electronically <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Upload link: See SAISA website > Forms page for the link • The format: MP3 • Free Skate and Short Program: these must be on separate CDs and separate MP3 uploads. Only Advanced Novice, Junior and Senior have Short Programs • Naming: File naming examples are below for ISA levels and Aussie Skate and consist of: the accepted name of the division (and segment if applicable), your name, and the actual length of your music: e.g.: JuniorLadies_SP_JaneSmith_2m40s AS_FS2_DonnaSmith_1m30s
Awards and Trophies	Medals will be awarded to all competitors. The Dejan Jovanovic Memorial Trophy and the Abram Family Cup will be awarded by the Jovanovic and Abram families respectively. See SAISA website (Awards) for further information
