ISU Anti-Doping Education and Certification Program - CLEAN SKATER

Ladies and Gentlemen,

The ISU and its Medical Commission are pleased to announce the start of the ISU Anti-Doping Education and Certification Program named "CLEAN SKATER".

"CLEAN SKATER" is an online interactive education program based on the education requirements of the World Anti-Doping Code. It will give skaters and their support personnel knowledge about key topics on Anti-Doping and give further motivation to pursue clean sport.

By completing the nine modules of the program, the users will gradually learn about Anti-Doping regulations, including doping control procedures, the WADA prohibited list, whereabouts, therapeutic use exemption and they will become more aware of their own actions, as well as see the consequences of doping.

The program is available in six languages including English, French, German, Spanish, Russian and Chinese.

Upon successful completion of the modules the user will be registered as certified.

Although the "CLEAN SKATER" program will start off as optional, in the future it might become compulsory for all skaters who enter an ISU Event. Therefore we encourage each skater to obtain their Anti-Doping certificate as soon as possible.
