ISA Anti-Doping Policy

In accordance with global changes to Anti-Doping Rules, ISA has adopted a new Anti-Doping Policy as of 1st January, 2009.

All Skaters within Australia are governed by the national jurisdiction of the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority (ASADA), the Australian Sports Drug Medical Advisory Committee (ASDMAC) and this policy.

When skating internationally Skaters are also governed by the international jurisdiction of the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) and the International Skating Union (ISU). The ISU Anti-Doping Rules and Procedures are available on the ISU website as ISU Communications 1547 and 1548.

The ISA Anti-Doping Policy can be found on the ISA website, skaters should periodically check the ISA website for any changes that may occur, particularly in this initial roll-out period of the Anti-Doping rules.

ISA Rules Section 11 Anti-Doping dated May 2006, is superseded by this policy and is withdrawn with immediate effect.
