

Membership Requirements	At close of entries, all competitors must be financial members of SAISA and the membership must be valid during the full competition period. All Aussie Skate entrants must be registered with ISA as well as their State body		
Guests	On application		
Eligibility to Compete	Competitors in Aussie Skate divisions must compete at the highest test level passed by the competition closing date and cannot enter a level lower than that which they have previously competed. Skaters who have passed the ISA Preliminary Test are not permitted to compete at Aussie Skate level (see ISA Rules for Pair and Dance exceptions)

Entry Process	 Entry registration form with payment details, PPC forms and music forms will be SAISA on-line forms. The links will be on the SAISA website > Forms page Note that skaters must also have a backup copy of their music such as on a USB drive or on their or their coach's rink music tag 	
Payment Process	 Payment is via the online entry form Synchro Team entry fees must be received in total as a team payment 	
Entry Conditions	Entry form and fee, music & PPC form must be received by close of entries for the entry to be accepted	
	There are 3 aspects to submitting your music:	
	1. The name: The name of your music is needed for your Entry form	
	2. Backup: Skaters must have a backup copy of their music, e.g. on a USB drive or on their or their coach's rink music tag	
	3. Online submission of your music	
	By close of entries skaters must submit their music electronically	
	The Upload link: See SAISA website > Forms page for the link (this is included with the entry form)	
	The format: MP3	
Music Upload	 Free Skate and Short Program are separate uploads and separate forms. Only Advanced Novice, Junior and Senior have Short Programs 	
	 Naming: File naming examples are below for ISA levels and Aussie Skate and consist of: the accepted name of the division (and segment if applicable), your name, and the actual length of your music: e.g.:

	Please ensure that your music is correctly labelled and the correct piece of music is uploaded.	
Withdrawals	Refund only with a medical certificate provided before the draw. No refund permitted after the draw

Coach Accreditation	Level 1 coaches and higher only are eligible to present skaters. Coaches must be current members of SAISA or another State body and wear their APSA accreditation ID with evidence of currency with APSA	
Working With Children Checks (WWCC)	All coaches, officials and volunteers must have a current WWCC check	
Volunteering	 Volunteers are essential for the competition Volunteers will be needed for: Judging system set-up and pack-up, Ice Marshal duties at the entrance to the ice, running Official Practice, competition music and announcing, presentations, and with the videoing and video replay for the judging system
