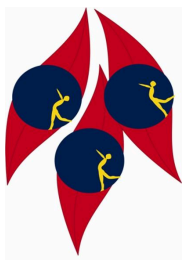
Event Officials	Judge/s, Technical Controller and/or Technical Specialist and Data Operator/Video Replay Operator for any scheduled events are by invitation and will be organised by the SA Judging Convenor.
Membership Requirements	<p>At close of entries, all Australian competitors must be a full financial member of their relevant State Association and an affiliated club. (inclusive of ISA Insurance Registration either directly or via their state association). The membership must be valid during the full competition period.</p> <p>All Aussie Skate™ entrants must also be registered with ISA Aussie Skate™ and currently enrolled in Aussie Skate™.</p> <p>Overseas entrants must be financial members of an ISU member skating organisation and/or its affiliates, as required by their national organization; the membership must be valid during the full competition period.</p> <p>Coaches must be current members of APSA and their relevant ISA Member (ISA-25)</p>
Insurance/Liability	<p>All members of State Associations are covered under the ISA National Insurance Policy while participating in the event. This policy includes Sport Accident cover.</p> <p>ISA & SAISA assume no responsibility for other persons in connection with this event.</p> <p>ISA recommends that any person travelling to an interstate event consider personal travel insurance.</p>
Eligibility to Compete	<p>Skaters Preliminary and above must have passed the relevant test level/s at the close of entries.</p> <p>Competitors in Aussie Skate™ divisions must compete at the highest test level passed by the competition closing date and cannot enter a level lower than that which they have previously competed.</p> <p>Aussie Skate refer: ISA Communication101</p>

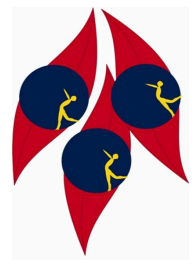

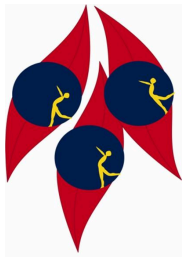

Entry and Payment Process	<p>Each skater is to submit an entry form electronically via the SAISA SA Skate 2026 JotForm. Competition information and form will be available on the SAISA website: https://www.saisa.org.au/default.asp?id=71</p> <p>The entry form contains payment, music and PPC submission</p> <p>For Synchronised entries, a Team Official must also submit their SST25-04F Sys Team Form(s), music and PPC via email to the Competition Convenor.</p>
Entry Conditions	<p>Entries will not be considered complete unless accompanied by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">o Full Payment paid on entryo Music File – submitted within JotForm with correct naming protocolo Planned Program Content Sheet (PPC) for all IJS-level programs to be received on entry or updated before close of entries <p>* Late entries will not be accepted</p> <p>Overseas entrants must have clearance from their ISU member to compete and confirmation of test level/equivalency is completed by ISA, prior to close of entries.</p>

Withdrawals	<p>Refund only with a medical certificate provided <u>before the draw</u>. No refund permitted after the draw. A 20% fee to cover costs may be deducted from the refund.</p>
Conditions for Online Entry	<p>All Interstate competitors must notify their relevant state association of their entry submission prior to entering.</p> <p>All state associations will be asked to confirm that entrants are full financial members in good standing, of both the state association and an affiliated</p>



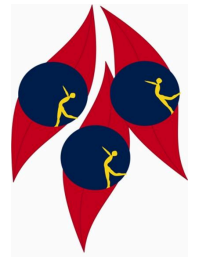

Music	<p>Online via competition entry form (Jotform). Any relevant music licensing fees that apply are included in the entry fee for this competition.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Refer ISA Music Protocol <p>Electronically: All competitors will submit a copy of their music electronically via the upload link in the entry form, with detail of each music piece. If not received by close of entries, the entry will be considered incomplete. Other Music file notes	<p>All competitors must have on hand at the event, a backup copy of their competition music on USB or RinkMusic music tag. Music on mobile phones will not be accepted. Back-up music must be held by the Coach rink side.</p> <p>Music (ISU Rule 343 Singles, Pairs & Dance and ISU Rule 823 SYS): Please note paragraphs 1a), 1b), 1c), 2, 3, 4, re: Music Reproduction.</p> <p>Each program (short program, free skating, pattern/rhythm dance, free dance) must be recorded on a separate file and labelled with competitor division, name and running time of the music. The electronic playlist will be deleted at the end of competition. All music remains the property of the skater and will not be shared or re-used.</p>
PPC	<p>Online via entry form (Jotform)</p> <p>Synchronised categories to email PPC to Competition Convenor by close of entries.</p>
Schedule	<p>A schedule of events will be available following close of entries and published on the SAISA website.</p>
Awards/Trophies	<p>Medals will be awarded to the first three place-getters of each division.</p>

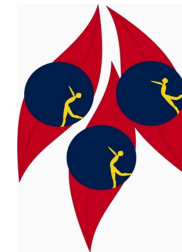


Working With Children Check	All coaches, officials and volunteers working with children must have a current WWCC check.
Coach Accreditation and Membership	<p>Level 1 coaches and higher only are eligible to present skaters.</p> <p>Coaches must be current members of APSA, their ISA Member and wear accreditation ID at the event.</p> <p>Coaches intending to present skaters are required to register via the Coach JotForm and provide confirmation of the following documents.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- APSA Accreditation- Working with Children Card or letter of confirmation
Volunteering	<p>Volunteers are essential for the competition. Indicate your (or parent/guardian if under 18) availability on the JotForm.</p> <p>The SA Competition Convenor will provide information, schedule and any relevant training for roles:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Accreditation desk- Judging system set-up and/or pack-down- Ice marshal duties at ice entrance- Running official practice (if applicable)- Hospitality assistance- Competition music- Competition announcing- Presentation assistance- Camera for the judging system

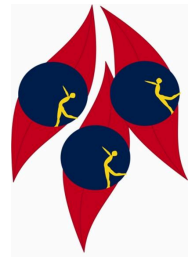
