

Policy Document Individual Sponsorship

Authority: SAISA Inc Board

Application: This policies applies to SAISA Inc <u>and</u> all of its affiliates

INTRODUCTION

The Board of SAISA is committed to ensuring that individual sponsorship is received in an ethical manner.

This policy applies to SAISA members, affiliated Clubs and their members and includes teams, volunteers, employees and coaches.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this document is to identify SAISA's position on individual sponsorship practice and to document the standards expected in accepting funds from the community.

DEFINITION

Individual: In this policy individual means a single member of the Association/ Club, a group of members or a team of members.


Sponsorship: This policy is intended to cover unconditional gifts or awards of funds or products and simple agreements. Sponsorship agreements usually require something in return for the sponsorship and can be very complicated and many will require legal advice that cannot be covered in this policy.

POLICY

Members of SAISA may accept directly any financial sponsorships and sponsorships in kind to assist them in training, travel to competitions intrastate, interstate or overseas and with other associated expenses on the following conditions:

- 1. The relevant club or SAISA (as appropriate) is notified in writing of any sponsorship not tied to any agreement (except for modest acknowledgement or reporting requirements) such as a donation, prize, scholarship, school activity, properly applied for individual grant, and
- 2. Approval is sought from SAISA before any sponsorship agreement is concluded; and
- 3. The person or other entity providing the funding or sponsorship and its products or services is appropriate to SAISA objectives, standards and ethics, and

- 4. If relevant, it complies with ISU (Ice Skating Union) regulations on trademarks, and
- 5. Sponsorship does not clash with or compromise SAISA, Club or rink sponsorship, and
- 6. Does not breach any Government funding obligations (e.g. contributions from pharmaceutical/gambling/tobacco/alcohol companies may not be appropriate), and
- 7. Is not classed as club/association fundraising (see below).

Team and Club Fundraising

Individual sponsorships are not to be confused with club fundraising. Members and/or their parents may not run raffles and other fundraising event in the name of a Team, Club, or SAISA for the benefit of themselves or their children. All proceeds of raffles or other fundraising events must be dealt with in accordance with SAISA and affiliated Club policy.
