Aussie Skate[™] through to Senior and may include Singles, Pairs, Synchronized Team Skating, Solo Dance and Adult conducted in

accordance with the rules of ISA

VENUE: Ice ArenA, 23 James Congdon Drive, THEBARTON, SA

ICE SURFACE: 26m x 56m

DATES: 11th July (Wednesday) and 12th July (Thursday)

TIMES: Competition Times: Wednesday 4.30 – 7.30pm, Thursday 4:30 – 7:00pm

Official Practice Times: Wednesday and Thursday 7.00am - 9.30am

CLOSING DATE: 7th June (Thursday)

DRAW: Draw for initial start order will take place at the Ice ArenA on:

Tuesday 25th of June at 5.30 pm

DIVISIONS: Singles: Preliminary to Senior and Adult

Aussie Skate: Divisions from the new Aussie SkateTM syllabus only

Pairs: Pre-Primary, Primary and Novice

Solo Dance: by expression of interest by 18th May only Only the Pattern Dance (compulsory dance) will be offered

Synchronized: free-skate program for Novice and Adult; Short program

only for Junior and Senior

Other Divisions: by expression of interest

ENTRIES: All entries must be submitted through State Associations

ALL ENTRANTS MUST BE REGISTERED AND INSURED MEMBERS

OF ISA as well as members of their State Association.

Current financial members of SAISA have been registered by SAISA

ENTRIES WILL NOT BE VALID UNTIL THE ENTRY FEE IS RECEIVED

(the entry fee includes Official Practices)

ENTRY FORMS FOR DIVISIONS TO BE MARKED USING THE ISA JUDGING SYSTEM (IJS) WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT THE

COMPLETED PPC FORM.

Entries received after the closing date will run the risk of not being accepted. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of SAISA and

will incur a penalty of double the entry fee

Discounts:

Second skater in family: less \$ 10.00 Second and further event: less \$ 10.00

WITHDRAWALS:

No refund is available after the draw. A fee of \$15 will be withheld for withdrawals before the draw.

PRACTICES:

Practice times will be advised after the draw. The amount of time available is limited. A division warm-up and one run-through of each program will be allowed. Grouping of divisions may be necessary. The entry fee is included in the competition entry.

REGISTRATION:

The official registration desk will be located inside the coffee shop area. Competitors must check in at the registration desk between 3.30pm and 4.00pm each day. Please note that Public Session will be running until 4.00pm. Skaters can hand in their music and pick up any notices at Official Practice in the morning.

MUSIC:

There must be only **ONE** track on the clearly labelled CD. The competitor's name, division, the program type (short or free skate) and the length of the music (not the program) must be written on the CD. The Official Practice Session is a good opportunity to confirm your music is working. Music must be handed in at Registration or Official Practice and must be picked up from the music steward after the event. Skaters should bring a spare working copy of their music CD with them.

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS:

The new Aussie Skate TM curriculum will be used. ISA levels are as specified for this season by ISA. Please note that new rules were recently released. The relevant documents can be accessed from the SAISA website (technical page) at www.saisa.org.au

MARKING & DETERMINATION OF RESULTS:

All marking will be closed marking. The 6.0 will be used for Aussie Skate divisions. The ISU Judging System will be used for Singles divisions from Preliminary upwards and wherever possible for Pairs, Solo Dance, Adult, and Synchronized Team events.

TROPHIES:

Trophies/medals will be awarded to all skaters.

PRESENTATIONS:

Presentations will be held off ice in the coffee shop area on each day after all the events have finished. All skaters please remain in costume for photographs.

AFTER COMPETITION DINNER ARRANGEMENTS:

Please contact the Announcer on the day for further information.

VIDEO RECORDING & PHOTOGRAPHY:

Photography and videotaping can give rise to child protection concerns.

Flash photography is not allowed during the event as it poses a danger to the skaters. Private recording of the event is not allowed. An Official Video (DVD) and photographs of the event will be organized if possible. This will depend on there being sufficient interest. A deposit (refundable) of \$ 20 is needed with your expression of interest. Further information will be available after the draw.
